## **Ishinomaki Senshu University Tent Site Regulations**

\*This is a place lent by the university. Currently, because a few have broken the tent site rules, we have received a warning, and the Volunteer Center is at its risk. If the Volunteer Center were to be closed, we would not be able to continue with our relief activity. We'd thus like to kindly ask you to follow the regulations and carry out relief support. Please note that we will ask those who cannot follow the regulations to leave the tent site. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

1. For those using the tent site (both individuals and groups), please come to the Volunteer Center (1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Building 5) for registration.
2. You may not use waterworks. Please use the portable toilets on the map. We lack portable toilets due to the increased number of volunteers. Portable toilets are cleaned by group volunteers, themselves. We'd like to kindly ask you to use the toilets in a clean manner. Also, when there is a clog, please stop using the toilet and inform us of the issue.
3. Do not smoke outside of the designated smoking areas.
4. Please take out your own trash (as a ground rule).
5. Ishinomaki Senshu University, Ishinomaki City Disaster Volunteer Center, and Ishinomaki Disaster Recovery Assistance Council are not responsible for any theft or trouble on the campus. Please keep your belongings with you.
6. Please do not enter the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> (Rooftop) floors as the ceilings may fall down with the aftershocks.

<Car Regulation>

1. The road on campus is one-way only. Please refer to the map and drive safely.
2. Please park your vehicles in the designated parking lot. (Refer to the Map) Also, it is strictly prohibited to park on the grass.
3. Please enter from the north gate and exit from the south gate.
4. Please fill out the vehicle permission and display it on the front glass where it can be seen.

<Tent Site Regulation>

1. There are many people resting on the tent site. Please be quiet from 10 P.M. until 6 A.M.
2. It is prohibited to drink on campus.
3. It is prohibited to make a bonfire on campus. Please use your own stove burner for cooking and use fire safely.
4. Please put a sticker with your full name and your group name on your tent. Please set up your tent carefully as there may be strong winds during certain seasons. Also, when going out for the volunteer work, please put your belongings back in your tent. When leaving after finishing the volunteer work, please clean up your own mess.
5. Please set up your tent within the designated area. (Refer to the Map)
6. Please do not use the trees or other facilities on campus to dry your clothes.
